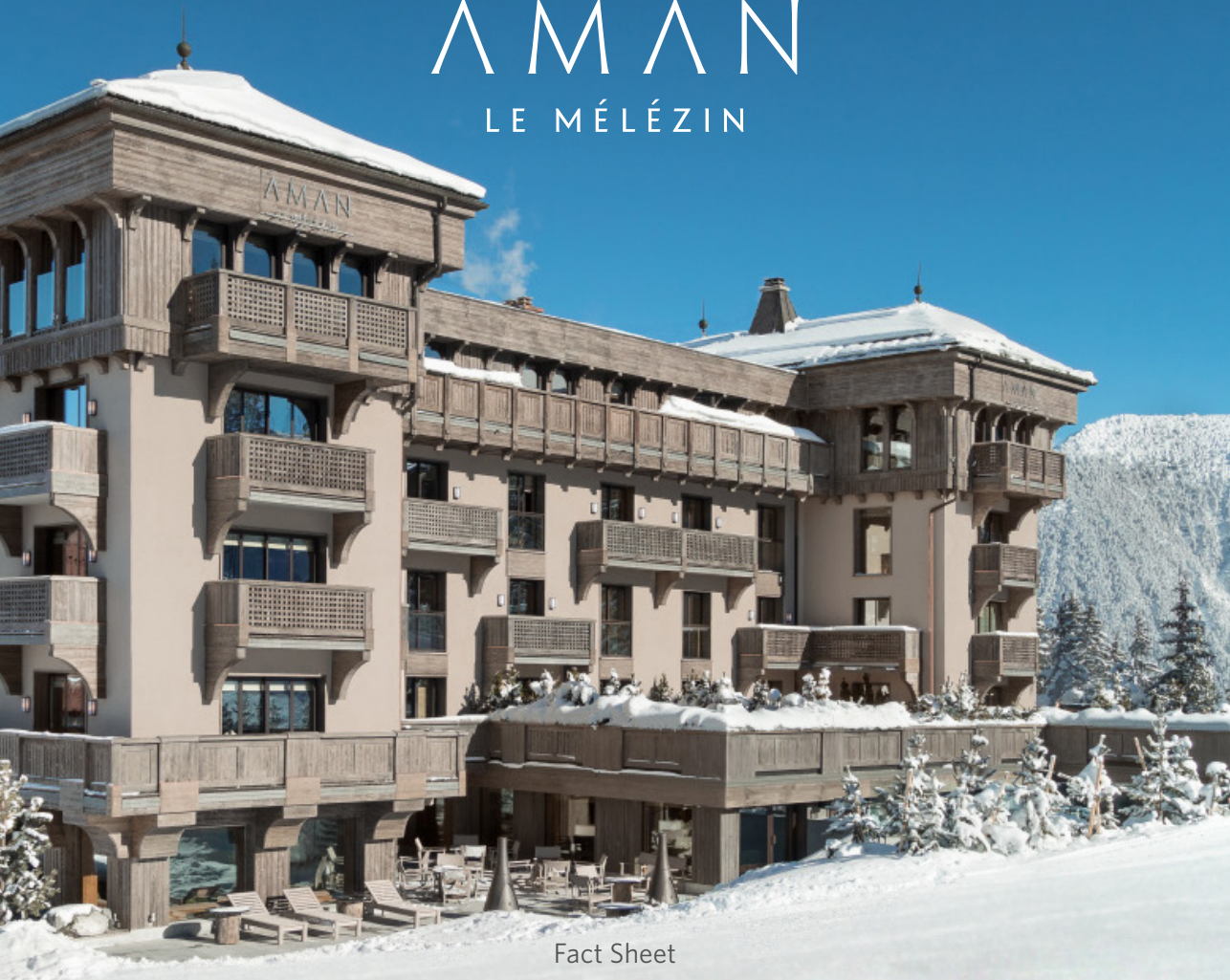

An iconic Alpine retreat in Les Trois Vallées, Aman Le Mélézin combines an unparalleled location directly on the Bellecôte Piste with exceptional ski-in, ski-out and après-ski facilities and a spa, dedicated to rebalancing both body and mind. Along with this, Aman Le Mélézin has opened its own newly refreshed and extended restaurant, terrace and bar areas just a glide away from the bars, boutiques and restaurants of Courchevel 1850.

Location

- Ski-in, ski-out property in the Savoy region of France
- Direct access to Les Trois Vallées, famous for its consistently excellent skiing conditions, with 600 kilometres of pistes
- Directly on the slopes only 200 metres away from Courchevel 1850
- Surrounded by spectacular mountain vistas and snow-dusted forests of pine and larch

Getting There

- Helicopters can land at Courchevel Altiport, a few minutes' drive from Aman Le Mélézin
- The concierge can arrange private charters to and from domestic and international airports
- 2.5 hours' drive from either Geneva or Lyon airports
- Paris is seven hours away by road
- Four hours by fast TGV train from Paris to Moûtiers-Salins, then 40 minutes by car to Aman Le Mélézin

Climate

- -15 to 5°C in winter (December to February)
- -5 to 10°C in spring (March to April)

- Daily scheduled morning yoga classes
- Access to wellness facilities including indoor heated pool, Jacuzzis, sauna, Hammam and cold plunge pool
- Access to Ski Room with ski-valet service
- Use of dedicated Kids' Zone for children

Accommodation

Aman Le Mélésin's 31 rooms (23 with balconies) open via floor-to-ceiling windows to views of mountain, forest and piste. The hotel's recent refurbishment saw its rooms and suites completely renovated, offering a restful, elegant aesthetic with oak panelling, large dressing areas and French furniture. Additionally, a new sun terrace and bar area have been introduced to the hotel.

Ski facilities & concierge

Aman Le Mélézin's ski in, ski out area offers equipment for hire and purchase and heated boot racks. Ski butlers attend to each guest's needs, laying out equipment as required each morning, and helping with any necessary maintenance. Private instructors, mountain guides, ski passes, transportation, restaurant reservations and more can all be arranged by the concierge.

Les Trois Vallées

Offering 600 kilometres of groomed pistes and more than a dozen cross-country routes, the world's largest ski area encompasses Saint-Bon (Courchevel and La Tania), Allues (Meribel and Mottaret), and La vallée des Belleville (Val-Thorens, Les Menuires and St. Martin de Belleville). Each area offers distinctive advantages: choose Val-Thorens for the highest slopes, or La Saulire in Courchevel for the best snow and some of the world's most taxing black runs. Meribel offers excellent red slopes. A fourth valley, la Maurienne, can be accessed by skiing or by gondola to Orelle. Snowboarders are well provided for at Courchevel, with its snow parks, snow rides and half pipes. Heli-skiing is also popular.

Other winter sports

Aman Le Mélézin can assist guests with outdoor climbing, snowshoeing, snowmobiling, paragliding and hang gliding. The Parc National de la Vanoise is nearby: though there are no ski trails or lifts here, the scenery is beautifully unspoilt. In Courchevel 1850, guests can enjoy an indoor climbing wall, bowling alleys and ice-skating at the Olympic rink.

Après - ski

Courchevel 1850 is just 200 metres away from Aman Le Mélézin, offering guests a lively mix of convivial bars, chic boutiques and elegant restaurants. Lit from start to finish, the Courchevel toboggan run takes guests down the two-kilometre route from Courchevel 1850 to Courchevel 1550.

Les Prés de la Croix

Sating appetites stimulated by the pristine Alpine air, Aman Le Mélézin's thirtieth anniversary dining experiences include an Evening Adventure at Les Prés de la Croix, a picture postcard mountain chalet.
