Amangani in Winter

Amangani is located in the southern half of the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem, a huge expanse of mountains, meadows, wilderness, sage flats, streams and rivers. Contained within this vast ecosystem are national forests, wildlife refuges and Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks, as well as the fabled valley known as Jackson Hole.

Beautiful throughout the year, in winter Jackson Hole transforms into a surreal wonderland. Abundant snowfall blankets the valley creating a natural playground for snow-sport fans and a sanctuary for wildlife lovers. Though some animals hibernate, others like bison, elk, moose, mule deer and wolves descend into the valley seeking food and shelter. With animals in such close proximity, wildlife encounters and viewing opportunities abound.

Primely positioned atop East Gros Ventre Butte, Amangani offers a wide selection of experiences allowing guests to take full advantage of the season's attractions.



Adventure Experiences

Within Jackson Hole's rich and varied ecosystem adventure abounds. In addition to our Amangani Signature Wildlife Tour, skiing and snowboarding excursions are offered in conjunction with the most professional outfitters in the area.

Amangani Signature Wildlife Tour

As snow piles up at higher elevations, animals such as elk and mule deer migrate to the valley floor and make themselves visible to humans for the first time in several months. Our experienced guides will tailor your tour according to weather conditions and wildlife behaviour, carefully choosing a route to showcase the grandeur of Jackson Hole.

Tours can include the famous Elk Refuge where big horned elk are likely to be seen or the Gros Ventre Range where moose and eagles can be spotted.

Alternatively, venture through Antelope Flats, better known as the historic Mormon Row near the southeast corner of Grand Teton National Park.

Amangani Snowshoeing

Snowshoeing is an intimate and unique way to explore the vast wilderness of Jackson Hole. Half- and full-day guided tours into pristine backcountry areas yield unprecedented opportunities for wildlife viewing, exploring the natural environment and enjoying breathtaking views of the Teton, Gros Ventre and Wind River ranges. Shorter two-hour tours explore our neighbourhood on the Butte and showcase magnificent views of the mountains, the valley and the town of Jackson without having to travel far from home.

Your naturalist guide will educate you on winter ecology, interpreting animal tracks and sharing the geological history of the mountain ranges.

For the more independent adventurer we can assist in planning a self-guided snowshoeing excursion. Grand Teton Park is a mere 35-minute drive from Amangani, so access is quick and easy.

Jackson Hole Mountain Resort

Located in the alpine community of Teton Village, the ski area covers a vast range of terrain offering more than 2,500 skiable acres. Thirteen lifts, including the world famous Big Red tram and a high-speed quad, offer diversity and unparalleled access. The combination of one of the greatest lift-serviced vertical drops in North America (4,139 feet) and an average annual snow fall of 450 inches provide you with some of the best skiing and snowboarding anywhere in the world.

Teton Village is located 25 minutes from Amangani and offers shops, restaurants, bars and a host of recreational activities. Private instructors are available for half-day and full-day excursions.

Advance direct purchase of lift tickets and lessons are recommended to manage mountain capacity. Lift tickets can and often do sell out during peak periods.

Lift tickets and private lessons must be purchased with Jackson Hole Mountain Resort directly.

Amangani Ski Lounge

When you are ready to ski, it is our pleasure to chauffeur you to the slopes of Jackson Hole Mountain Resort in our courtesy shuttle which departs from just outside the Lobby. A 25-minute drive takes you to the Amangani Ski Lounge in Teton Village. Located at the base of the Bridger Gondola, we store your ski gear as well as provide snacks, hot beverages, private restrooms and an excellent sunroom from which to spectate.

With 3,000 acres of lift-served accessible terrain and an average annual snowfall exceeding 500 inches, the conditions at Grand Targhee are unrivaled for powder. Considered one of the most diverse ski areas in the US, Grand Targhee also offers over 15km of trails for Nordic skiing and fat biking. Rentals for both are offered in the base area. This resort presents a serene atmosphere with minimal lift-lines, spacious slopes and small shops and restaurants to serve your needs.

Snow King Resort

Founded in 1939 as Wyoming's first ski area, Snow King boasts North America's steepest trail, top to bottom, just a 15-minute drive from Amangani. Snow King is a great choice not only for skiing, but also offers family fun by way of the Cowboy Coaster, a terrain park, a snow tube park, an ice rink and a ski school. On-site ski and skate rentals at the Snow King Center are also available.

Nordic Skiing

Nordic skiing provides you with access to some of the most beautiful and picturesque areas of Jackson Hole. There are several Nordic Centres located in the valley, offering miles of impeccably groomed terrain for all skill levels. For the more adventurous, there are several tour companies that offer half- or full-day excursions. Alternatively, we can suggest some of our preferred routes so you can venture out on your own.

The Grand Teton National Park is a 35-minute drive from Amangani, offering quick and easy trail access. Winter in the park brings solitude with the Tetons providing a stunning backdrop to your skiing experience.

Ice Skating

Ice skating is great for families or anyone looking for an activity away from the slopes. The valley has several outdoor skating rinks available to the public as well as one indoor rink. One can free skate or join in an informal stick and puck ice hockey session. Reservations are not required.

Outdoor Rink – These rinks are open daily and have fluctuating schedules. Please inquire about the various time slots upon arrival. A few of these rinks provide rentals of skates on-site.

Indoor Rink – Located at the base of Snow King Resort, the Snow King Center provides the valley's only indoor rink. The schedule fluctuates throughout the winter season. Please inquire about times upon arrival. There is a skate rental shop on-site.

Fat Tire Biking

Half Day/Full Day

Contrary to what one might think, cycling in the winter is a popular activity thanks to the introduction of fat tire mountain bikes. These ultra-lightweight, stud tire bikes provide a whole new experience to the cycling enthusiast. Snowmobiling

Two Hour / Half-day Tour / Full-day Tour

Take in winter scenery in Wyoming's expansive backcountry, snowmobiling through the wilderness. Jackson Hole has several tour companies offering a variety of full-day and half-day journeys complete with professional guides.

Dog Sled Tours

One Hour / Half-day Tour / Full-day Tour

A dog sled tour is the best way to see the beautiful scenery of Jackson Hole without effort or the noise of engines. While flying through Bridger-Teton or Targhee National Forest, the only sounds you will hear are the "shushing of the runners, the panting of the dogs and the wind in your face. Before departing on your adventure, you might journey to the kennels to meet the dogs and the musher who will be your guide.

We highly recommend booking in advance as these trips are in high demand and often fill up quickly.





Sleigh Rides

Group/Private

Wrapped in a blanket, take a sleigh ride into the National Elk Refuge, winter home to more than 10,000 elk that migrate from the mountains as the season changes. Your guide will provide insight into the lives and habits of these great animals as you fly over the snow.

Over the festive season, enjoy a moonlit, horse-drawn sleigh ride from Spring Creek Ranch along the ridge line of East Gros Ventre Butte. Or combine a private ride in a handcrafted sleigh with JH Vintage Adventures along the banks of the Snake River with dinner at Tipi Camp and/or hot chocolate on the way.

UTV Tours

Two-Hour Tour

Take a ride through Bridger-Teton National Forest in a heated, fully enclosed Can-Am Defender UTV. Your guide will drive the UTV, winding through the forest to the Upper Green River Lakes Elk Feeding Ground, where supplemental forage is supplied to help ensure the elks survival. Here you can view elk as they graze before exploring further.

Horseback Riding

Whether you desire a leisurely walk through the forest in communion with your mount or a gallop through open, snow dusted meadows, bring your dreams to life as you venture through vivid red rock mesas set against the dramatic backdrop of the white-capped Absaroka Mountain Range in Dubois, WY.

Expert wranglers will introduce you to your four-legged friend before saddling up for a two-hour excursion completely customised to your level of riding ability. Wildlife abounds including pronghorn, elk, mule deer and more. Warm up after your ride with homemade hot beverages and charcuterie.

Adventures by Air

High Mountain Heli-Skiing

Ski the pristine faces and bowls of the Snake River, Hoback, Palisades and South Teton Mountain Ranges via helicopter. Offering low guest-to-guide ratios, which will enhance your skiing experience, the Bell 407 helicopter will allow you to explore the magnificent mountains that rim the valley.

A full day will give you access to some of the most exhilarating mountains in the West. Your trip will include lunch and consist of at least six runs and more than 13,000 vertical feet of skiing.

Scenic Airplane Flight

This scenic flight in a Cessna Hawk XP will take your party over the Teton Mountain Range and the valley of Teton County Idaho. This is without a doubt the easiest way to experience the full splendor of the mountains and provides a great opportunity for taking spectacular aerial photographs.

Yellowstone Photo Flight by Helicopter

Experience an unforgettable aerial photo flight over the greater Yellowstone ecosystem in a private helicopter. There is no better way to appreciate the nearly 3,500-square-mile landscape of dramatic canyons, alpine rivers, lush forests, hot springs and gushing geysers.

The National Museum of Wildlife Art

Intriguingly designed, the museum's sandstone building overlooks the National Elk Refuge and brings together more than 2,300 works of art from the early 19th century to the present. The museum features 12 exhibition galleries showcasing a permanent collection of wildlife art, as well as several innovative rotating installations.

Jackson Hole Center for the Arts

The Center for the Arts is home to many local arts organisations, educational activities and other community gatherings. The centre houses a state of the art Performing Arts Pavilion, which includes a 500-seat theatre and a music centre. They offer a wide spectrum of events such as theatre productions, music concerts and films, as well as art talks, openings and exhibits. The Off Square Theatre Company is based at the Center for the Arts.

Jackson Hole History Museum

Explore 11,000+ years of human history in Jackson Hole at the Jackson Hole History Museum, owned by local resident, History Jackson. The space comprises an interactive Main Gallery and exhibition-focused Upstairs Gallery alongside historic cabins, activity areas, a museum shop, classroom, archive, research centre and more. Spend the day exploring its collections of over 7,000 artefacts, 19,000 photographs, 11,000 archival documents, nearly 4,000 books and 600 oral histories.

Winter Fly Fishing on the Snake River

Jackson Hole is home to some of the world's best trout fishing. The lakes and streams below the Tetons feature one of the few remaining populations of the wild cutthroat trout as well as many other game fish. A professional guide can lead you to some of the most secluded fly-fishing spots on the Snake River or one of the many other trophy fly fishing spots in the Valley. To maintain the balance in the ecosystem, all fishing tours are catch and release.

Ice Fishing

Half Day/ Full Day

Enjoy ice fishing in the breathtaking scenery of the Wind River Mountains, located just outside of Pinedale, Wyoming. All ice fishing equipment is provided, plus portable ice huts and heaters to keep you warm. Settle into your chair inside the ice hut while guides drill holes to fish in, then use depth/fish finders to help hunt down the fish, most of which are trout.
