Amanpulo

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Amanpulo is a secluded private island hideaway in northern Palawan, Philippines. Fringed by white-sand beaches, turquoise waters and a coral reef, the resort includes 42 Casitas and 17 Villas, along with an extensive Aman Spa, several restaurants, PADI dive and water sports hut, seasonal kitesurf and space for bespoke events.

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Amanpulo is a secluded island retreat in northern Palawan, Philippines. Fringed by white-sand beaches, turquoise waters and a coral reef, Pamalican Island is dedicated to Amanpulo, instilling a safe, private escape. 42 Casitas are situated on the beach or on the hillside, while the 17 Villas are on the shoreline. Palm-lined paths lead to several restaurants, Aman Spa, organic farm, Sea Sports Hut, the PADI Dive Centre, the seasonal Kite and Surf Centre, and various venues for bespoke events.

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Amanpulo, meaning 'peaceful island', is a secluded island retreat in northern Palawan, Philippines. 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Amanpulo, meaning 'peaceful island', is a secluded island retreat that bestows a safe, private escape to nature. Fringed by white-sand beaches, turquoise waters and a coral reef, Amanpulo is accessible via private plane from Manila in a 90-minute flight that touches down on the island's very own runway.

Located in the Cuyo Archipelago of northern Palawan in the Philippines, Pamalican Island is solely dedicated to Amanpulo. The island boasts 5.5 kilometers of beaches and is home to a rich diversity of flora and fauna.

Scattered across the island, all 42 Casitas fulfil the promise of a hideaway. Treetop and Hillside Casitas are perched on highland, Treetop Pool Casitas feature a plunge pool, and the Deluxe Hillside Casita offers panoramic island views. The Beach Casitas are nestled along the shoreline, while the Beach Pool Casitas feature infinity pools that seamlessly blend into the sea view.

Tucked in pockets of privacy along the beach, the 17 Villas of Amanpulo are secluded hideaway homes imbued with the generosity of space designed for seamless indoor-outdoor living. The one-, two-, three-, four-bedroom Villas sit on expansive properties with a private pool and spacious living and dining pavilions at the heart of the complex. The Villa stay comes with the service of a dedicated butler and chef.

Club cars are provided for independent island exploration. Hidden away on the island's summit is the Aman Spa, offering an enriching selection of holistic wellness facilities and treatments. Palm-lined sandy paths lead to a selection of dining options with menus that use ingredients from the island's flourishing organic farm.

Adventure facilities include the Sea Sports Hut with a variety of water-sports equipment and cruising options, the Padi Dive Centre, the Kite and Surf Centre, and various venues for bespoke events.

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Meaning 'peaceful island', Amanpulo on Pamalican is part of the Cuyo Archipelago, located 288 kilometres south of Manila and boasting all the idyllic beauty of a tropical island retreat. Fringed by white-sand beaches, turquoise waters and a coral reef, the whole island is dedicated to Amanpulo.

Part of the Quiniluban Group in the northern region of the Philippine province of Palawan, Pamalican is a low-lying coral island encircled by seven square kilometres of pristine reef. The island is just over five kilometres long and only 500 metres across at its widest point. It has its own runway, and flights from Manila take approximately 60 minutes.

Elevated on the hillside or set by the beach, Amanpulo's 42 Casitas, some with private pools, are loosely modelled on the traditional Philippine *bahay kubo* ('native dwelling'). The decorative interior details of these twin-roofed bungalows reflect the natural surroundings: pebble-washed walls, coconut-shell tables, rustic Palawan baskets and rattan headboards on the king size beds. Sliding glass doors reveal expansive decks and twin divans, while large Cebu-marble bathrooms feature twin vanities, separate changing areas, a shower and an elegant bathtub lit by large windows with wooden shutters.

The resort's 17 Villas are located on the shoreline and consist of one-, two- or four-bedroom pavilions set around a private swimming pool. Each Villa has a unique layout that provides multiple living and dining areas indoors and out. Its expansive facades offer a striking architectural design that seamlessly blends with the surrounding natural beauty. Guests can also enjoy exclusive access to a private beach, providing a serene and secluded retreat by the sea. The Villas are serviced by a dedicated butler and chef.

All guests have access to a buggy for unlimited island exploration. At the heart of Pamalican, on a gentle rise, is the Clubhouse, which has a library, boutique, and a 30-metre swimming pool. The Clubhouse restaurant offers Filipino specialties and club classics all day, and the bar provides an elegant ambience. This western shore is the tranquil setting for Amanpulo's Beach Club, open seasonally and features Mediterranean cuisine along with fresh seafood. Located on

the east side of the island, the Lagoon Club is also open seasonally with a decadent Japanese menu. By the beach, the Picnic Grove seasonally opens to serve pizzas cooked in traditional wood-fired ovens, and is a favourite venue for toes-in-sand events.

Situated on a hillside with views of the sea, the Aman Spa consists of a series of pavilions including a reception pavilion and finishing salon. Each treatment room offers a deep-soaking bathtub, dressing area and steam shower, along with magnificent sea views. The Pilates pavilion also enjoys beautiful views and is available for private or group classes. The fitness pavilion houses a yoga studio, a spacious gym, hydrotherapy suites and outdoor relaxation areas.

Additional facilities include floodlit tennis courts, a multi-sport court, the Sea Sports Hut with a variety of water-sports equipment, the Dive Centre and various venues for bespoke events.
